

I was so interested in this other, longitudinal and surpassing touch that happened again and again in a book both measured and dreamed: the pictogram, for example, that s heard rather than seen; the blood that s mailed back north a stain, my zero. What does it mean to encounter a zeroa stranger that doesn t diminish in repetition, but which strengthens, glitters, hurts to look at directly or feel? Brent Armendinger writes into this quality or crucial space with an emotional and soulful approach to the amniotic potential of vocabularies, human and otherwise. What do the birds think?
