If he should have removed beyond the jurisdiction of the Commissioners, or cannot be found, or his place of abode be unknown, the precept may be affixed on the door of the church or chapel of the place where the Commissioners meet, and it then becomes binding upon him. A return is to be made to the precept within the time limited, subject to the penalty of 20, and treble the duty at which the person ought to be assessed. If the Commissioners are dissatisfied with the schedule, or require further information, they may put any questions touching the contents, or any matters which ought to be contained in it, and from time to time issue...
