

Each of these methods has its advantages and its disadvantages, but many of the disadvantages grow out of the abuse of the method. STORING. In the eastern and central portions of Kansas, where wheat cut with the binder is allowed to stand in the shock until threshed, much of it deteriorates in quality and condition because of this exposure to the weather. Much of it stands out in poorly set-up shocks, unprotected by cap bundles, and the effect of alternate rain and sun is to cause the branny coat to swell, loosening it from the endosperm, and the kernels to lose their natural bright appearance, or bloom. The amount of moisture in the kernels increases, and continued exposure will soon cause the grains to sprout. All this injury causes the wheat to give a lighter test weight per bushel and detracts from its quality and general appearance. Consequently such wheat is given a lower grade when shipped to market, and it brings a lower price. On the other hand, wheat harvested too green is not good for flour-making purposes, and if cut with a header and stacked fermentation and heating in the stack may take place until the interior of the kernel is rendered unfit for the manufacture of flour. This heating may take place in the bin after threshing if the wheat contains much moisture. Wheat damaged by fermentation and heating is usually...
